Parents Evening: Hendon Madrasah cordially invites you to attend Parents Evening. Parents Evening is very important as you will have an opportunity to discuss your child's progress and any other concern with the class teacher. Please support your child's Islamic education by attending parents evening. You will also be forwarded the mid-year assessment paper.

Date of Parents Evening: Thursday 25th January 2024. Madrasah closed for students on the day. *Please note: Parents Evening for all Year 7 groups is on the same day as above.*

Timing: Parents Evening has been staggered due to pupil numbers. Each class will have 2 sessions as below:

Session 1 is: 5.00pm to 5.50pm for students whose FIRST name begins with letters between A - M. Session 2 is: 5.50pm to 6.40pm for children whose FIRST names begin with letters between N - Z.

Parent Evening Tickets:

Upon arrival, please collect a ticket from the corridor of both buildings before proceeding into the main hall. Madrasah staff will direct you to the designated area. To ensure a smooth parents evening, please co-operate with them. All parents will be seen on a 1st come, 1st served basis using the 'parents evening ticketing system'.

- > FEES: If children have any outstanding fees, please visit the office.
- ➤ **No Parking:** Parents are requested to find suitable parking as highlighted regularly in previous newsletters. There will be no parking facility on site due to safety concerns and also due to insufficient space.
- ➤ Attendance: Please only attend at the time you have been called and before 6.40pm or you may not be seen. Attendance is a requirement. Please also note that Madrasah will be closed for students on Parents Evening. You are requested to arrange for supervision of your children at home on the day.
- > Time Per Parent: The teacher will not be able to give you more than 5 minutes as you will appreciate that there are other parents to be seen in the limited time. If you wish to discuss any issue or concern in more detail, we can arrange an appointment for another day.
- > Segregation: Our Lord has chosen for us Islam as our religion. It is He who gave us guidance through His beloved Messenger (s.a.w.s.) and gave us guidance in every aspect of life. The Masjid is the central point in a Muslims life and should promote the ethics of Islam in its entirety. It is for this reason we make the following humble request:
 - We request that sisters attend to see the Muallimah's (female teachers)
 - Brothers are requested to attend and see the Sh. Shuayb who teaches (Year 7 & 8 Boys).

However, if it is difficult or you feel it necessary, then any parent may see the teacher. Parents are requested to dress strictly according to the guidance of Qur'aan & Sunnah and observe the Islamic dress code.
